## **Identity Presentation**

- 1. Give a **7-10 minute presentation** about your life, explaining who you are and how you became this person.
  - 2. Create something that represents who you are and show it to the class.
- 1. Presentation possible questions to consider:

#### Past:

- Where did you grow up? What is your hometown like?
- What were you like as a child?
- Who is in your family?
- Where did you go to elementary, middle and high school?
- What activities did you participate in growing up?
- What experiences shaped you?

#### Present:

- Who are you? What makes you different from others? What makes you YOU?
- What are some of your personal character traits?
- Who and what made you into the person you are?
- What are the most meaningful relationships you currently have in your life?
- What is the most important thing in your life?
- What inspires you and keeps you motivated?
- What was the hardest thing you ever encountered? How did you deal with it? Who helped you along the way?
- Has your identity changed over time? How? Has it been a positive or negative change?

#### Future:

- What are your dreams or goals?
- What is your purpose in life?
- Who do you want to be in the future?
- How will you get there?

### 2. Creation – you *must* answer:

- What did you create?
- How does it represent you?
