 - Supportive



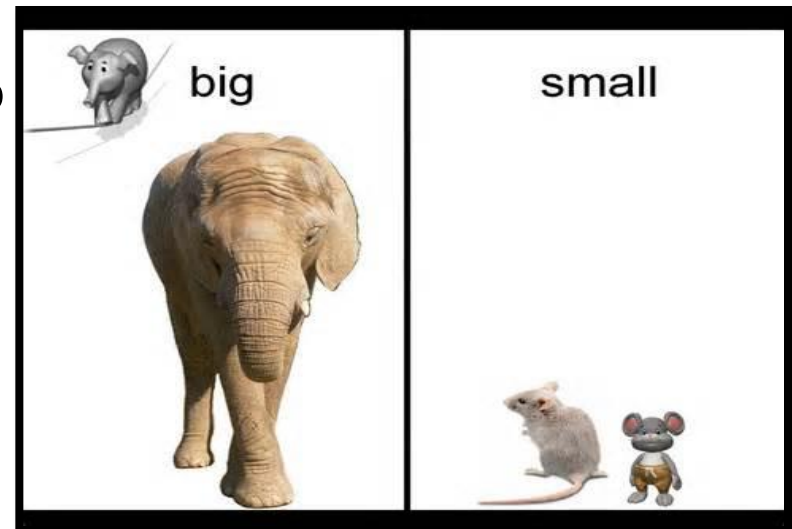
